Church, our 100th anniversary is on the not-too-distant horizon. As I think about this significant milestone, I find myself nearly overwhelmed by the legacy of our church and how God has used us on the Front Range and around the world over the past 83 years. The only emotion that eclipses my gratitude for our past is anticipation of our future.

We say all the time at Mission Hills Church: this isn't about numbers. Every number has a name. Every name has a story. Every story has an ending. And every ending has a sequel: heaven or hell. Unfortunately, there is an ever-widening gap between the overall population and the Christian population of the Front Range. There is an epidemic of apathy towards faith here and, sadly, most churches are plateaued or declining in their impact.

We believe God is calling Mission Hills to play a catalytic role in changing that.



MISSION HILLS CHURCH HISTORY


God's faithfulness and provision have been evident to Mission Hills Church since 1942.

- A small group of believers gathered in the little, red Curtis Schoolhouse at University and Orchard, united by a desire to grow in faith and share the love of Jesus.
- Our first building was purchased, and we were able to hire our first full-time pastor, Reverend Robert Noles.
- With a heart for reaching more people, we expanded our worship space. Though challenges arose, the people of Mission Hills Church remained steadfast in prayer, seeking God's direction.
- 1970 Through a renewed commitment to prayer and discipleship, the church experienced a season of healing and growth. God was forming a community deeply rooted in his mission.
- Mission Hills stepped boldly into a new chapter, expanding both our physical space and our outreach. We continued to embrace out calling to reach those far from God, a vision that would define our future.
- After a season of prayer, we sold our facility to Aspen Academy.

 We were miraculously enabled to purchase a property at Broadway and County Line.
- Our new building in the South Park Business District opened. We saw unprecedented growth, and many people came to know Jesus as their Savior and experienced transformed lives.
- We purchased a building in North Littleton for a Community Center, now known as The Life Center. This was another mighty display of God's power, timing, and provision.
- Following an 18-month, nationwide search, Pastor Craig Smith was called to be our lead pastor.


 Our Español Campus started as a Bible study and soon grew into a Sunday-morning congregation.
- **2018** We expanded our facilities at our Littleton Campus and saw rapid growth of our Online Campus.
- 2022 Our North Littleton Campus began meeting in the Life Center building to expand our reach for both our Life Center clients and the surrounding community.
- 2023 Our Castle Rock Campus launched in Douglas County High School on Easter Sunday.

What:


We'll strengthen the Mission Hills Association, expand Life Center outreach, and plant churches globally to bring the Gospel to unreached areas.

Help people overcome challenges and live with purpose by providing resources and support through Care Ministries like Re|Engage, Re:Generation, Financial Peace University, and more.


EQUIP THE NEXTGENERATION

ENHANCE EXISTINGFACILITIES

Create welcoming environments where ministry can thrive by improving and updating the Littleton Campus, North Littleton/Español Campus, and the Life Center.

ESTABLISH A NEW PERMANENT CAMPUS

Secure a permanent home for our Castle Rock campus, which currently sets up each weekend at Douglas County High School. We have an option on a piece of land and are open to this being what God has planned for this campus, but we are actively looking at other, less-expensive options.

We also know that the resources available to us here dwarf the resources available to most Christians throughout the world. We have a responsibility to leverage those resources both across the street and around the world. We believe that our investments in Colorado will bless the world, and that our work around the world will only serve to accelerate our work here on the Front Range.

ADVANCE GLOBALMISSIONS

Deepen relationships with our current global outreach partners and make a new investment in The Timothy Initiative to plant churches, fund strategic projects, and bring the Gospel to the leastreached people groups around the world.






To fund our existing ministries at their current level of impact and keep up with rising costs, we need to raise \$29 million over the next two years.

Prayer Prompt:


What "boat" in your life is Jesus asking to use? What provision is he asking you to abandon so you can follow the Provider? Ask him to show you and to provide the faith to follow.

INTRODUCING THE BEYOND FUND

Traditional giving is separated into categories such as tithes and offerings, missions, special offerings, building campaigns, etc. You prayerfully consider what to give to each fund separately, or participate in some giving categories and not others. We want to be a church that goes beyond and the BEYOND FUND is our unifying commitment that everyone who gives is a part of funding for ALL ministries, missions, and projects.

We are on ONE MISSION, to reach every person on the Front Range and beyond. We are excited to introduce the BEYOND FUND, a single fund, to unify the generosity of everyone at Mission Hills Church.

On April 12 + 13, you will be invited to make a two-year BEYOND COMMITMENT. We believe God will reveal to you the number that will represent your total, radical, sacrificial generosity to the Kingdom over the next two years.



WAYS TO GIVE

The Beyond campaign's goal is \$53 million — a number that's bold and beyond anything Mission Hills has ever set out to achieve. We believe this is a God-sized goal, one that only he can make possible.

BIBLICAL STEWARDSHIP

We're inviting everyone who considers Mission Hills Church their home to prayerfully seek God's direction in making a financial commitment.

Biblical stewardship isn't measured in equal amounts but in equal sacrifice, reflecting the unique resources God has entrusted to each of us.

A POSTURE OF GENEROSITY

Generosity is more than a number; it's a posture of the heart. Pray about how God wants you to steward what he has entrusted to you.

APPRECIATED ASSETS

Many people own securities that have achieved unrealized gains in value over the years. That is good news. The bad news is that if these assets were sold, a significant portion of the gain would be lost to taxation.

Gifts of appreciated assets—typically investment securities or real estate—can be very advantageous to both the donor and the church. By transferring ownership of the asset to the church, the donor avoids income taxes on the sale of the asset. Unlike gifts of cash that have already incurred an income tax, gifts of appreciated assets avoid the incurrence of capital gains tax. In addition, the donor receives a charitable tax deduction for the full market value of the asset. That, in effect, makes these gifts less costly to make.

Importantly, before making a commitment of this type, please consult your CPA, tax attorney, or other financial advisors.

INCREMENTAL GIVING

Giving does not have to be in equal increments over the next two years. You might be able to give more in the second year than in the first. As you think about your financial commitment to Beyond, think not of just your potential to give right now but also of your potential to give in the future. It might be that you can make a two-year commitment which 70% is given in the first year and 30% in the second year.

GENEROSITY PATHWAY

If you're currently giving **NOTHING**, we invite you to start giving **SOMETHING**. This will bless you and others. You don't have to give to belong to Mission Hills Church, but when you start to give, you start to grow in peace and joy.

If you're currently giving **SOMETHING**, we invite you to start giving something **CONSISTENT**. Take the step of faith to return some percentage of your income back into God's hands as a demonstration of your trust in him and a commitment to joining Jesus on mission in the world.

If you're currently giving something **CONSISTENT**, we invite you to start giving a **TITHE**. This is the biblical word for the first 10% of any resource that God blessed his people with.

If you're currently giving a **TITHE**, we invite you to start practicing **SPIRIT-LED SACRIFICIAL GIVING**. This is when we give the first 10% of our income to our home church and then pray about additional opportunities to use our resources to join Jesus on mission in the world.



At Mission Hills Church, we believe that giving first honors God. Saving second practices wisdom. Living on the rest builds contentment.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How does my giving to Beyond affect other types of giving, like general funds or missions?

During this two-year initiative, most financial gifts (including weekly recurring gifts and special one-time gifts) to Mission Hills will contribute to our Beyond Fund. This includes funding for all our ministries, campuses, missions, and community outreach. Every dollar given will fuel our ongoing ministry and the vision God has for our church to go Beyond.

The **three exceptions** are that you can designate your giving for the Life Center, for Care (our benevolence fund), and to support someone going on a Short-Term Trip.

Why now?

Mission Hills is approaching our 100-year anniversary, a milestone that invites us to reflect on God's faithfulness and dream about the future. This is a pivotal moment to honor our legacy by stepping boldly into the next chapter of impact. The time to act is now, so that by the time we celebrate 100 years, we will have laid the groundwork for reaching everyone on the Front Range with the Gospel and leaving a lasting legacy of faith for generations to come.

What are you asking me to do?

First and foremost, pray. Ask God to lead you in how you can be part of this initiative. Consider what sacrificial generosity might look like for you and your family during this season. Engage with others in small groups and discussions to explore this together. Finally, prepare your heart to see God work in incredible ways as we step out in faith.

Can I give non-cash gifts, like stock or property?

Yes! We encourage creativity in giving. Non-cash gifts such as stock or property can make a significant impact. If you'd like help facilitating this kind of gift, please reach out to our team for assistance: **contributions@missionhills.org**.

Can I designate my gift to a specific ministry?

All gifts (including general fund giving) will count toward the overall Beyond initiative, which includes support for specific ministries. By giving to Beyond, you are contributing to the full vision God has placed before us as a church.

The **three exceptions** are that you can designate your giving for the Life Center, for Care (our benevolence fund), and to support someone going on a Short-Term Trip.

What if I'm not in a position to give right now?

We believe everyone can participate in Beyond, regardless of financial circumstances. Generosity isn't about the amount—it's about the heart behind the gift. If you're facing financial challenges, we encourage you to ask God how he might lead you to trust him in new ways. This could mean you participate by praying or serving with your time and talents.

What if I've never given before?

Beyond is designed with you in mind. This is an opportunity to take your first step into generosity and discover the joy that comes with living on mission with Jesus. It's not about a specific amount; it's about taking that first step of faith.

I'm new to Mission Hills. Should I participate in Beyond?

Absolutely! Beyond is a perfect opportunity to learn about the mission and vision of Mission Hills Church and to be part of something bigger than yourself. This initiative is for everyone, whether you've been here for years or just started attending. That said, there's no pressure to commit right away—take time to pray, ask questions, and learn more about what this could mean for you.

How long is my commitment?

We're asking for a two-year commitment from May 1, 2025 to April 30, 2027. This allows us to dream big, plan strategically, and see the Gospel advance both here on the Front Range and around the world.

What if I'm paying off debt?

If you're focused on paying off debt, that's great progress, and you should continue to work toward financial freedom. However, giving is about what God wants for you, not from you. Generosity, even in small amounts, can be a step of trust and worship as you follow him.

Can I adjust my commitment later?

Why is this initiative called Beyond?

"Beyond" reflects our vision to go further than ever before—to reach beyond ourselves, beyond our buildings, and beyond our church. It's about creating a legacy of faith, generosity, and Gospel impact for generations to come.

What if the Castle Rock campus doesn't work out?

We are pursuing a permanent home for our Castle Rock campus, including exploring a specific piece of land. However, we remain flexible and open to other options that align with God's plan. Our commitment is to continue growing and reaching people in the Castle Rock community, whether through this location or another that God provides.

What is The Timothy Initiative?

The Timothy Initiative (TTI) is a global movement dedicated to advancing Christ's Kingdom by multiplying disciples and establishing disciple-making churches worldwide. Rooted in the principles of 2 Timothy 2:2, TTI trains and equips local leaders to plant churches, particularly focusing on areas and people groups without a Gospel presence. Their mission is to see a church in every village, everywhere, ensuring that every person has access to a community of believers.


